UAE Aid Bulletin: Horn of Africa, Libya, Pakistan and Turkey

15 December 2011

In 2011, UAE donors have reported to the Office for the Coordination of Foreign Aid (OCFA) contributions totaling AED 107.3 million (\$29.2 million), and pledges totaling AED 3.2 million (\$0.8 million), towards ongoing relief efforts for the food crisis in the Horn of Africa (AED 55.0 million), the complex emergency in Libya (AED 45.7 million), the floods in Pakistan (AED 6.4 million) and the earthquake in Turkey (AED 73,500). OCFA is reporting these records with the United Nations Financial Tracking Service (UN FTS). The table below is a corrected version of the table published on 15 November:

Recent activities of UAE donor organizations, as reported through the media:

Pakistan

- The **Khalifa Bin Zayed Al Nahyan Humanitarian Foundation** has provided relief items to those affected by the floods with an amount of AED 1.8 million.

Recent activities of UAE donor organizations, as reported through the media:

Donors have recently announced the following activities through the media, which have not yet been reported to OCFA.

Horn of Africa:

- **The Emirates World Humanitarian Mobile Hospital** has so far treated 20,000 patients residing in camps in the Horn of Africa as announced on 19 November. The medical teams have also trained the African medical team. Surgeons have also conducted an eye surgery for an old woman returning her sight.
- **Sharjah Charity Association** announced on 25 November, that it has collaborated with Al Rayyan charity to provide the daily bread for five thousand Somali families with a cost of USD \$16,000. The project is an extension of 'Aghithohm' or 'Save Them' campaign.
- **The Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan Humanitarian Foundation** is currently building water wells and 25 basins in different areas in Hargeisa the capital and Burao towns in Somalia as announced on 10 December.

Turkey:

- **The Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan Humanitarian Foundation** sent humanitarian assistance from Ankara to the victims of the earthquake which struck Turkey's southeastern city of Van as announced on 25 November.
